



Step 4: Add your course (FSE 150)

Click on the “Add course” button next to the course you want to enroll in, then click “Enroll”

⚠ Please note when you enroll in a course, you're automatically enrolled in **preview mode**. You must upgrade to the credit-eligible track to receive credit and add the course to your transcript.

Step 5: Upgrade the course (REQUIRED for FSE 150)

Once you are back on your dashboard, click the “**Access Course**” button. This will prompt you to either “**Upgrade this course**” or “**Preview this course.**” Because you want academic credit for FSE 150, then you will need to upgrade.

There is a \$25 cost to upgrade.

Upgrading a course means you are put onto the credit eligible track and once you pass all course requirements, you can add the course to your transcript.

Webcam




